Learn about the different birds that live near the Hudson River, and make your own beak and feet.

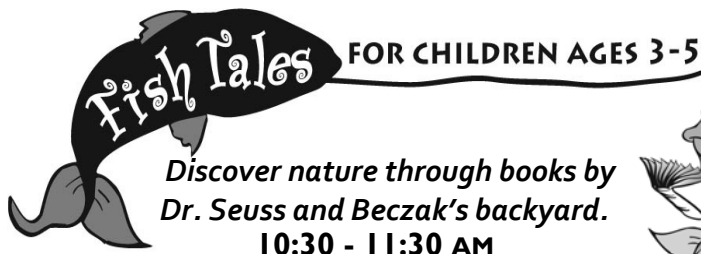
