### **Tuesday 2/16: SOUNDS OF NATURE**

Discover the unique sounds that surround the Hudson River watershed through nature-based activities, instrumental creations, and artistic expressions. Special guest musician will lead the children through interactive environmental songs.

### **Wednesday 2/17: BIRDS OF PREY**

Explore the fascinating world of birds and learn about their behaviors, physical features and migration patterns. Children will see screech owls, hawks and other native birds presented by Greenburgh Nature Center.

### **Thursday 2/18: FISH EXPLORATION**

Children will get their hands wet as they identify the Hudson River creatures that lurk beneath the waves in Yonkers and inhabit Beczak's aquaria. A special distance learning component using video conferencing will connect the children to Norrie Point Environmental Center to compare species.

### **Friday 2/19: CELLS IN MOTION**

Children will have up-close encounters with plankton, microscopic bacteria and organisms using high tech microscopes and digital imaging aboard the "Biobus".
